Our cover depicts an adult *Tantilla rubra*, found on the eastern versant of the Sierra Madre Oriental of Tamaulipas, Mexico. The snake was found during the summer rainy season on a sunny limestone slope of pine, oak, and agave. The image was recorded by Robert Hansen, long-time editor of *Herpetological Review*. Hansen has made a number of trips to Mexico, most recently in conjunction with studies of kingsnakes of the *Lampropeltis mexicana* complex. In addition to Hansen, the field crew on this trip consisted of Tim Burkhardt, Terry Hibbitts, Troy Hibbitts, and Ron Savage.
