Alejandro Solórzano is a Research Associate at the Museo de Zoología, Universidad de Costa Rica, who over the last 40 years has been studying the herpetofauna of the country. Included in his numerous contributions is the bilingual book *Snakes of Costa Rica: Distribution, Taxonomy, and Natural History*, published by INBio in 2004. For decades, he was the Director of the National Serpentarium, a private institution that displayed amphibians and reptiles for education and tourism. Pictured on our cover is a Costa Rican Hog-nosed Pitviper (*Porthidium volcanicum*), which Alejandro described in 1995. This species only is known from a few localities in southwestern Costa Rica, and in 2012 it was discovered in southwestern Panama.
